Step – 1

Access your exam by copying the unique URL from the received email and pasting it into the **Google Chrome** address bar. Log in using the provided credentials to begin the exam.

Troubleshooting Guide:

- Kindly conduct the system compatibility check on the actual device intended for the main exam to ensure seamless exam experience.

- Ensure that your microphone and camera are properly connected and operational before starting the check.

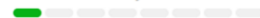
Step – 4

The system check process verifies all the requirements as shown in the right column. In the first step, your internet connectivity will be tested, as shown in the image. If the network connectivity is not optimum, try switching to a different network/connection.

Encountering connectivity issues?

Let's troubleshoot and get you back on track:

- Connect to Network: We recommend a minimum of 1 Mbps for optimal performance.
- Check Connection Speed: A minimum of 1 Mbps of internet speed for optimal performance with a stable connection is recommended.
- Slow Connection: Ensure that your microphone and camera are properly connected and operational before starting the check.
- If your network speed is less than 1 Mbps, switch to a broadband network or a mobile hotspot. After making the switch, restart the system check process for a smoother experience.

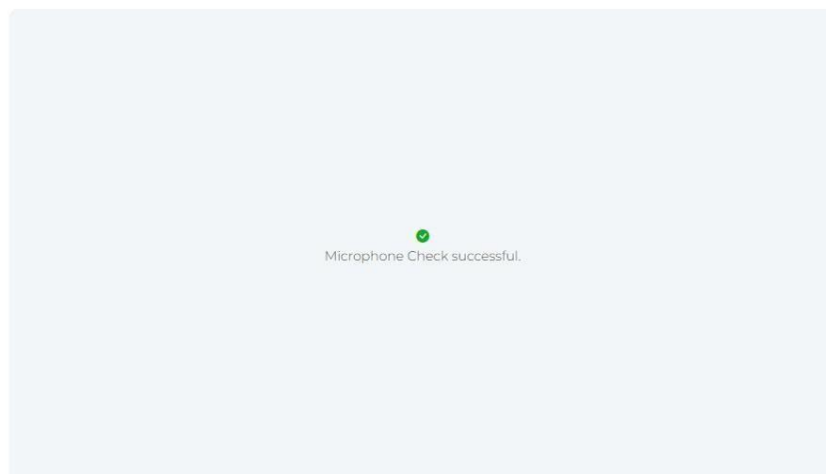
Step – 5

The system will test your camera and microphone. Ensure you've previously granted necessary permissions on the terms and conditions page.

For Mac users, ensure camera and microphone access is granted in your system's privacy settings before starting the exam.

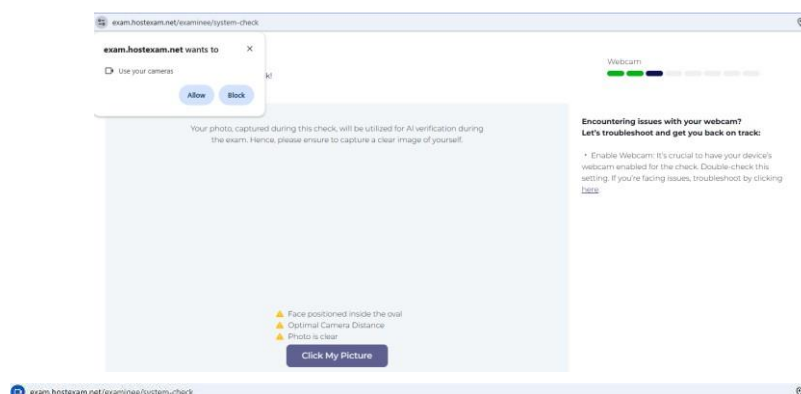

Allow access to the use of camera and click on “Click my Picture” to capture your picture. This image will be used to confirm your identity.



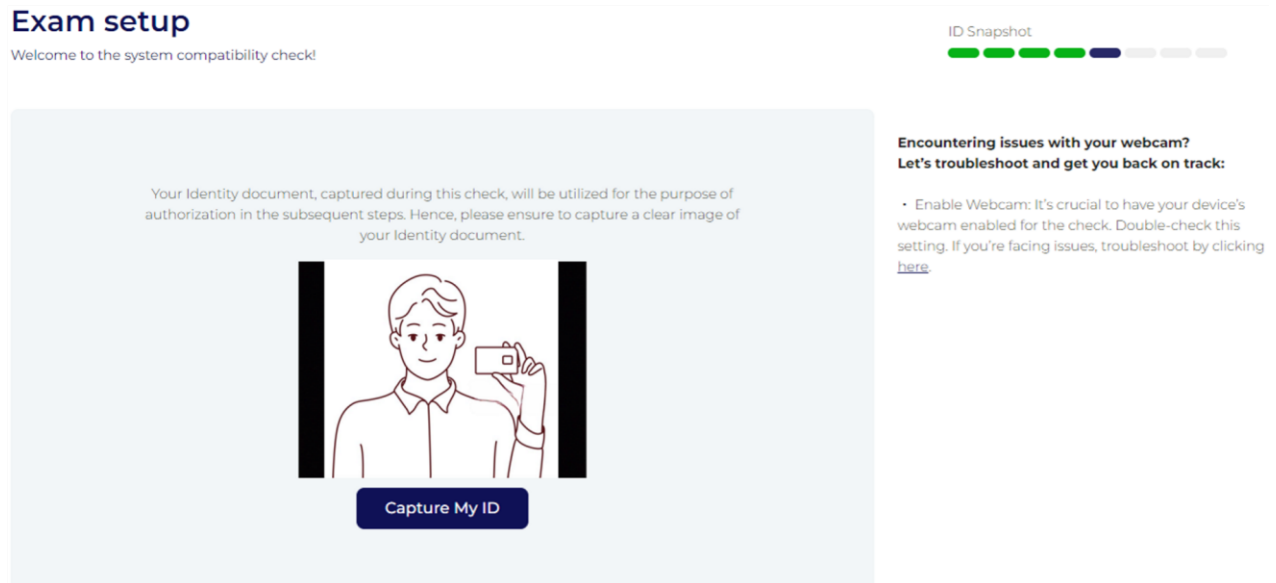

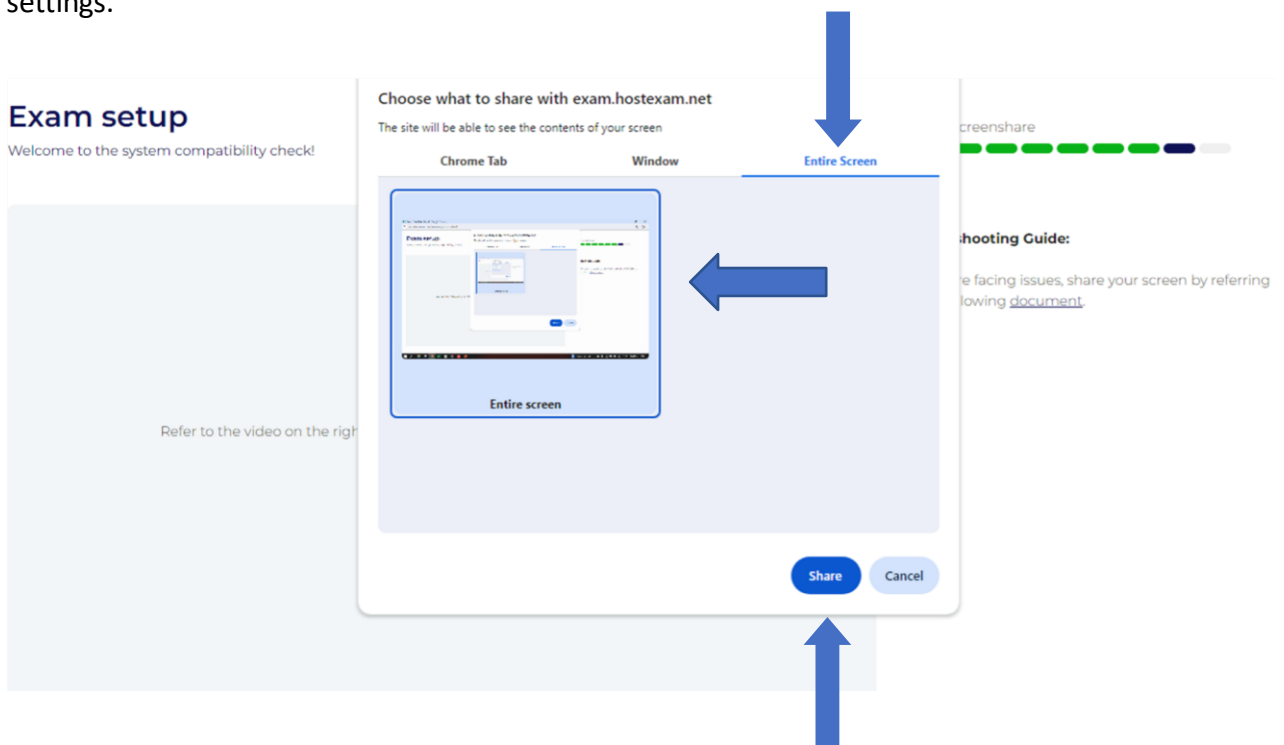
Step – 7

Capture a clear photo/picture for verification purposes (**no need to take the photo along with the ID card**). Ensure all details are visible.



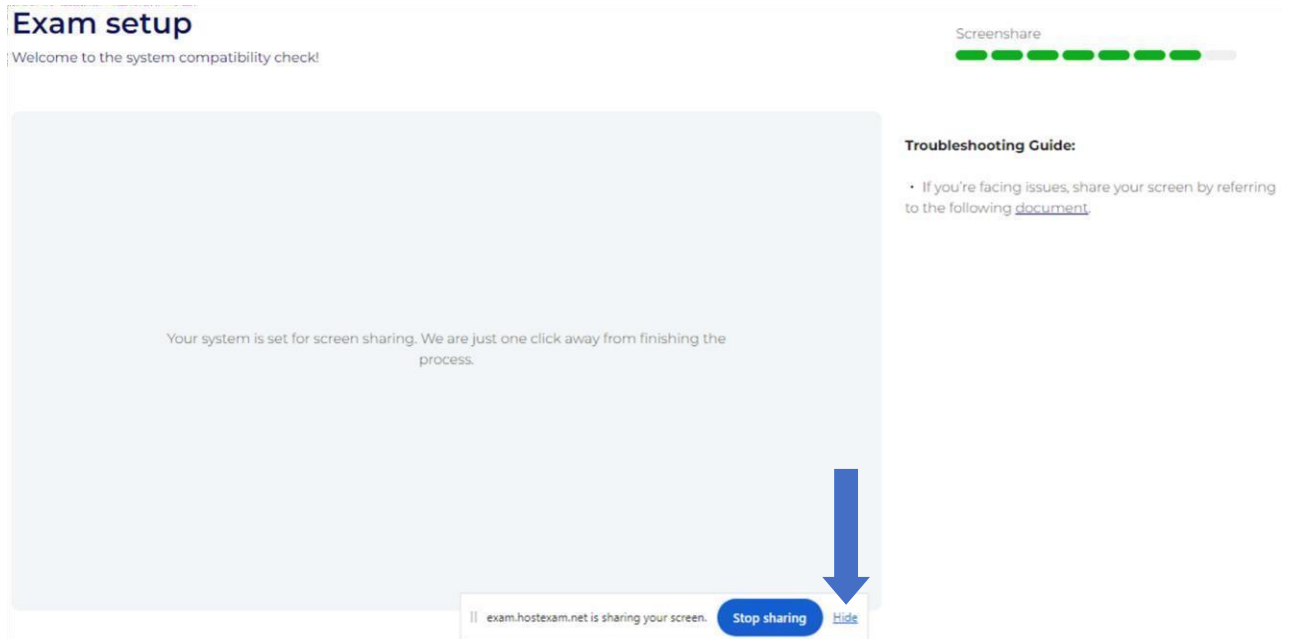
Step – 8

To share your screen, **select "Entire Screen" ONLY** from the screen sharing options. This is mandatory to proceed with the exam. Ensure screen sharing remains active throughout the assessment. Mac users must enable screen sharing in their system preferences and privacy settings.



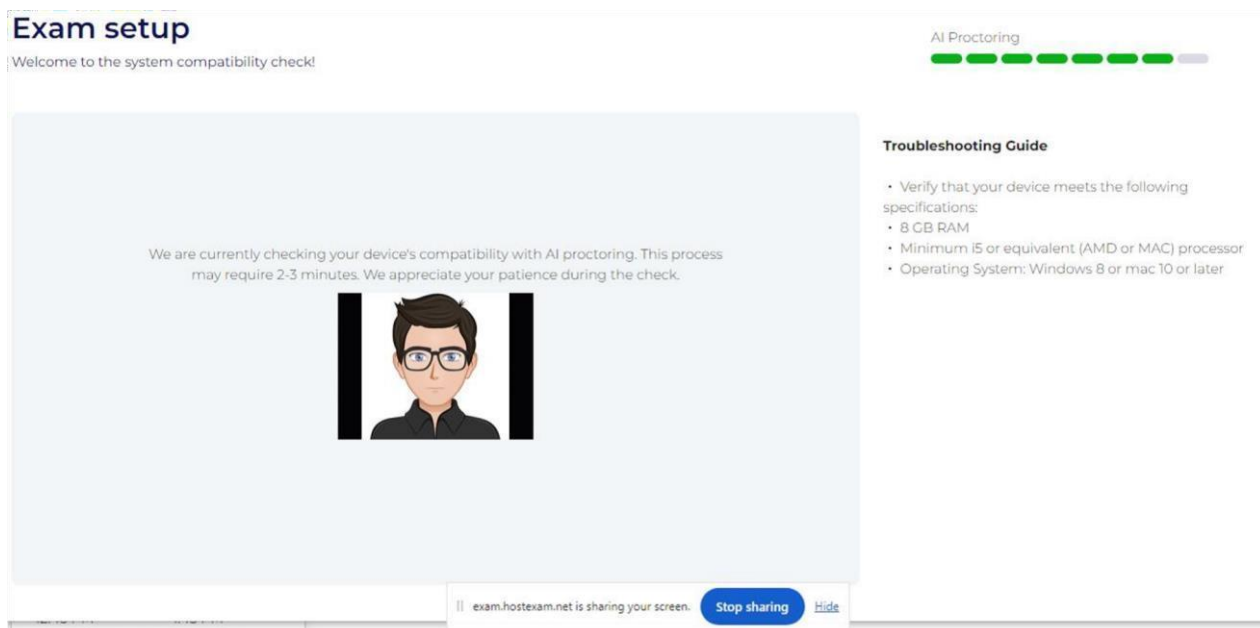
Step – 9

After sharing your screen **DO NOT** click on stop sharing button until the assessment ends. (You are only allow to click on hide button) and **DO NOT** refresh the page.

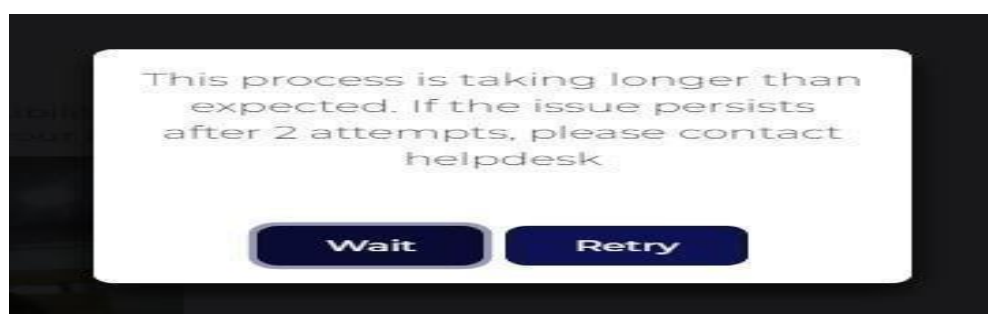
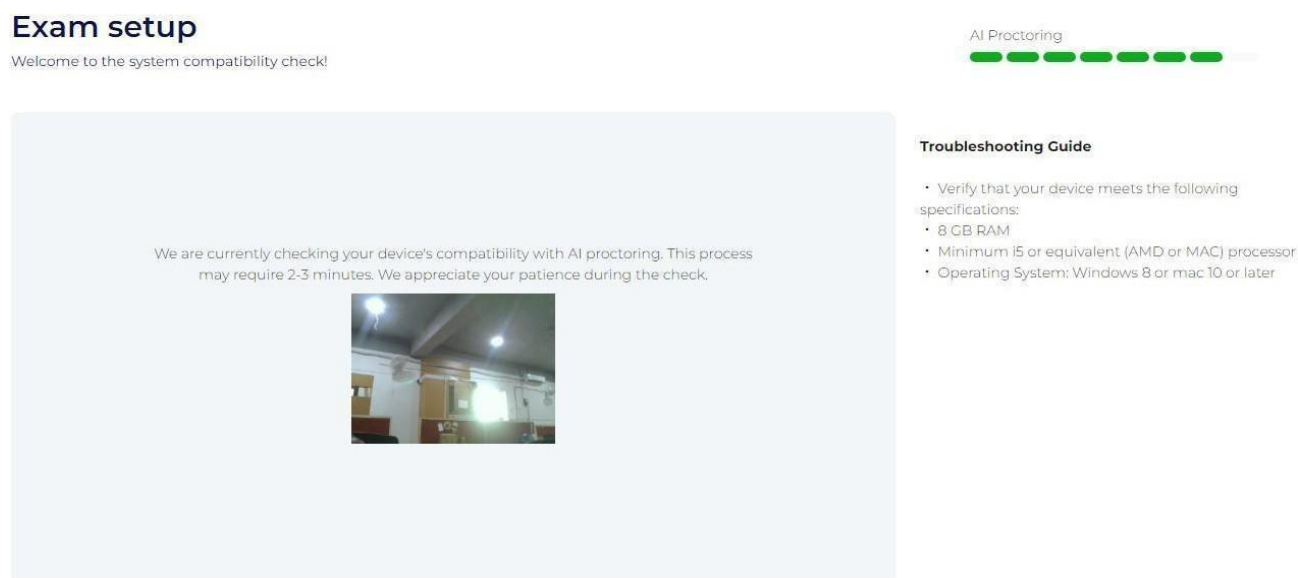


Step – 10

The system will check if your device meets the requirements for AI proctoring. Review the device specifications on the left for compatibility details.



If you encounter issues during the AI proctoring check after 2 failed attempts, follow the provided steps to resolve compatibility problems and proceed with the exam.

Then, enable “**Use graphics acceleration when available** ” and click on “**Relaunch.**”

Enable benchmarking

Sets all features to a fixed state; that is, disables randomization for feature states. If '(Default Feature States)' is selected, sets all features to their default state. If '(Match Field Trial Testing Config)' is selected, sets all features to the state configured in the field trial testing config. This is used by developers and testers to diagnose whether an observed problem is caused by a non-default base::Feature configuration. This flag is automatically reset after 3 restarts and will be off from the 4th restart. On the 3rd restart, the flag will appear to be off but the effect is still active. – Mac, Windows, Linux, ChromeOS, Android, Fuchsia, Lacros

Override software rendering list

Overrides the built-in software rendering list and enables GPU-acceleration on unsupported system configurations. – Mac, Windows, Linux, ChromeOS, Android, Fuchsia, Lacros

Accelerated 2D canvas

Enables the use of the GPU to perform 2d canvas rendering instead of using software rendering. – Mac, Windows, Linux, ChromeOS, Android, Fuchsia, Lacros

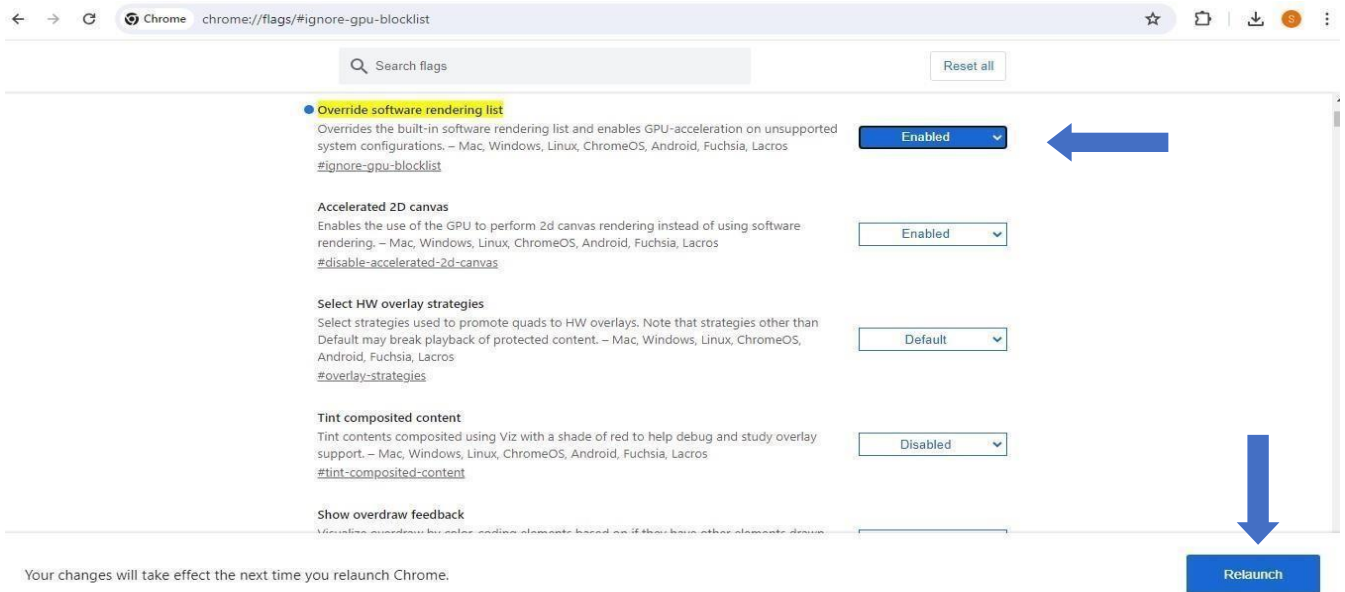

Enable "**Override software rendering list**", which is highlighted in yellow and click on relaunch the browser.

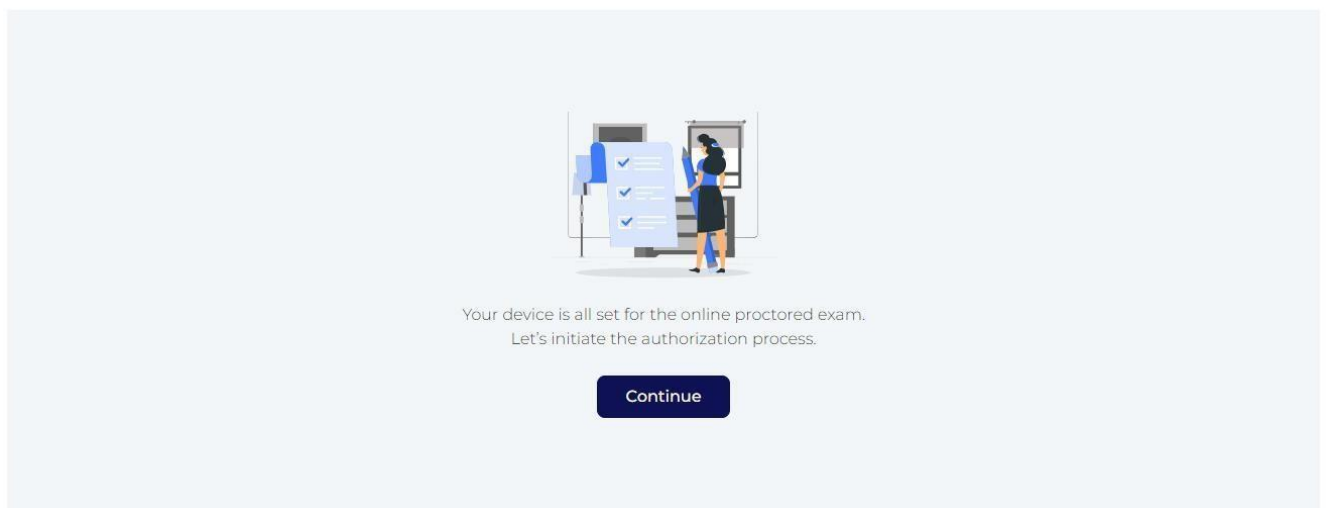

Do's – What You Should Follow:

- **Stay silent** and avoid any unnecessary movement or gestures.

- **Do not navigate away** from the exam screen; repeated attempts may lead to disqualification.

- **Do not speak or move your lips**, as it may be considered suspicious behaviour.
- **Do not sit in low light** or in a position where your face is not fully visible.
- **Do not leave your seat or camera view** at any time during the exam.
- **Do not look around or away** from the screen frequently, as this may raise red flags.
